1 - Dr. Andrea Bonior

Presentation: *“Working with Stressed Patients, Parents and Doctors.”*

Dr. Andrea Bonior is a licensed clinical psychologist on the faculty of Georgetown University. She is the 2020 recipient of the national Excellence in Teaching Award from the Society of the Teaching of Psychology (a division of The American Psychological Association), and was the longtime voice behind the mental health advice column “Baggage Check” for The Washington Post.

She is a mental health contributor to several television networks and writes a popular blog for Psychology Today, and maintains a clinical private practice. Her latest book is “Detox Your Thoughts: Quit Negative Self-Talk for Good and Discover The Life You’ve Always Wanted.”



2 - Dr. Jose Bosio

Presentation: *“Navigating Into the Dental Ankylosis World.”*

Dr. Jose A. Bosio is certified by the American Board of Orthodontics and serves as Clinical Associate Professor, Division Chief of Orthodontics and Postgraduate Program Director at the University of Maryland School of Dentistry. He received his BDS in Brazil in 1987 and his certificate in TMD from Eastman Dental Center, Rochester, NY, in 1993. He also received his MS and certificate in orthodontics from OSU in 1996. He returned to Brazil to work in private practice for 11 years. In 2008 returned to the US to serve as Assistant Professor at Marquette University while maintaining an active faculty practice.

He then served as Associate Professor at Rutgers SDM, New Jersey, from 2014 to 2017. Dr. Bosio has published one book on computer office management software and more than 30 publications on various orthodontic clinical outcomes. He received the 2011 AAO Thomas M. Graber Award, and Teaching Fellowship Awards from AAO in 2009 and 2010 and from AAOF in 2011 and 2012.

Dr. Bosio serves as Examiner for the American Board of Orthodontics since 2010 and as reviewer of many orthodontic journals. He is also the Past President for the Society of Orthodontic Educators (SOE).



3 - Dr. Marianna Evans

Presentation: *“Airway and periodontal rational for orthopedic skeletal development in the primary and early mixed dentition.”*

Dr. Marianna Evans is a board-certified dual specialist in Orthodontics and Periodontics practicing in greater Philadelphia area. She received her DMD degree and specialty training at the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. Evans frequently lectures on skeletal expansion, guided facial growth, interdisciplinary care and periodontal plastic surgery. She co-founded OrthPerio Institute and recently developed 4D Morphotropic Orthodontics expansion protocol with the focus on airway and periodontal health.



4 - Dr. Joana Forsea

Presentation: *“Class III Treatment Option with Skeletal Anchorage.”*

Dr. Forsea has traveled extensively and has practiced in multiple locations throughout the world.

She graduated OKU at NYU in 1995 and right after that completed her Orthodontic Certificate at NYU as well. She has been teaching at NYU and lecturing internationally since 1998 and since 2014 holds the position of Clinical Director at the NYU Department of Orthodontics.

She has published on current practices in orthodontics since she graduated, investigating the “truth” behind the newest approaches to many orthodontic queries.

Now, more recently, she is focusing on establishing a reproducible, private practice approach to skeletal maxillary modifications. This may include skeletal maxillary protraction and expansion.



5 - Dr. Heather Hopkins

Dr. Heather Hopkins is a partner in an orthodontic and pediatric dentistry private practice in Columbia, South Carolina. She has treated over 2,000 patients with clear aligners including a large number of teen cases. Dr. Hopkins attended the University of Kentucky for her dental degree and the University of Louisville for her orthodontic residency. Having lectured both nationally and internationally, she is passionate about teaching aligner biomechanics, systematic ClinCheck review, and

digital workflows.



6 - Dr. Laurance Jerrold

Presentation: *“Orthodontic Standards of Care: How did they evolve? What they are today? What will they be tomorrow?”*

Dr. Laurance Jerrold is the Chair Emeritus and Orthodontic Residency Program Director at NYU Langone Hospitals; the former Dean and Program Director of the School of Orthodontics at Jacksonville University; and prior to that, he was the Program Director for two other ADA accredited post-doctoral orthodontic programs. He received his DDS as well as his Orthodontic Specialty Certification from New York University. When he became Board Certified in Orthodontics he was recognized as the world's first 3rd generation board certified orthodontist. A firm believer in education he received his JD from Touro University, and his Certificate in Bioethics and the Humanities from Columbia University. His background includes over 20 years in the private practice of both orthodontics and law, and over 15 years in full time post-doctoral orthodontic academia and educational administration. He is the Associate Editor for the section on Litigation and Legislation in the AJODO. He has been recognized internationally for his contributions to the field of dental risk management and orthodontic education. He has presented or written over 450 lectures, articles, textbook chapters and multimedia presentations dealing with orthodontic practice, dental risk management, and clinical ethics for dental organizations throughout North America.

10 - Dr. Waldemar Polido



Presentation: *“Oral Surgery Update: Effective Communication, Virtual Surgical Planning, Implants and Airway Considerations.”*

Dr. Polido is an Oral and Maxillofacial Surgeon, with a Master's and Doctor (PhD) degrees at the PUC University in Porto Alegre, and an OMFS Residency at the University of Texas, Southwestern Medical Center at Dallas. He is currently a Professor and Acting Chairman of the Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery Department at the Indiana University School of Dentistry, and Co-Director of the Center for Implant, Esthetic and Innovative Dentistry. He is a Fellow of the International Board for Certification of Specialists in OMF Surgery, as well as a Member and Fellow of several organizations, including the IAOMS, AAOMS, Academy of Osseointegration Osteology Foundation, AO-CMF and the Brazilian College of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery. He serves also as a reviewer for the main journals in OMFS and Implantology, as the IJOMS, JOMS, IJOMI and COIR. His main interests are in Implant Dentistry Surgery, with a focus on Interdisciplinary Treatment, and in Orthognathic Surgery. He has many publications and lectures worldwide on several topics. Digital Tools, Bone Grafts, Minimally invasive techniques, Treatment of the esthetic area, Complications, and the Treatment of fully edentulous patients are some of the main themes for his lectures and publications.

11 - Dr. Kelton Stewart



Presentation: *“The Impact of the COVID-19 Pandemic on Orthodontic Practices in the US.”*

Dr. Kelton Stewart earned his Doctoral of Dental Surgery from Baylor College of Dentistry, Texas A&M Health Science Center. Following his dental training, he remained at Baylor to complete a residency program in orthodontics and a Master's program in Health Professions Education. Dr. Stewart joined the faculty at Indiana University School of Dentistry in 2008. He is the James J. Baldwin Associate Professor of Orthodontics and currently serves as the Chair, Graduate Program Director, and Clinic Director of the Orthodontic Department. His research interests include the assessment of orthodontic treatment efficiency and student performance predication and assessment.

Dr. Stewart has been recognized for his excellence in teaching and commitment to community service. In 2013, he was nationally recognized for his merit in teaching when he received the Omicron Kappa Upsilon Charles Craig Teaching Award. He is a three-time recipient of the Indiana University Trustee's Teaching Award for Excellence (2014, 2015 & 2019) and a recipient of the Johnson Public Health Faculty Community Service Award. Additionally, he was awarded the 2017 Indiana University School of Dentistry Outstanding Faculty Member award.

Along with his academic career, Dr. Stewart engages in active orthodontic patient care through his orthodontic practice in the Indianapolis area. In December of 2013, he became a proud Diplomate of the American Board of Orthodontics.

Dr. Stewart holds membership in numerous regional, national, and international organizations. During his professional career, he has maintained an active engagement in organized orthodontics. He has served as the President of several groups including the Indiana Association of Orthodontists, American Association of Orthodontists-Society of Educators, and Student Clinicians of the American Dental Association. He currently represents the Great Lakes Association of Orthodontists as the representative to the AAO Council on Orthodontic Education and Council on Scientific Affairs.

science.
